

Presidential Review

All members of the Ryerson community are invited to participate

The By-laws of the University provide that the Board of Governors is required to conduct a presidential review at this point in President Sheldon Levy's term of office. The presidential review process is prescribed in the By-laws. A Presidential Advisory Review Committee (PARC), which must be constituted to complete the presidential review, has been established. PARC is seeking input from members of the University community and key stakeholders regarding the President's reappointment. The By-laws require that the review include input from students, faculty, administrative staff, alumni, government representatives and donors. Consultations are taking place through a combination of written submissions and meetings with sub-committees of PARC.*

The President will have the opportunity to review the information PARC receives from the community. Following the consultation process, PARC will make its recommendation to the Board of Governors on the President's reappointment. After the President has decided whether he wishes to seek a second term and the Board has made a decision on reappointment, a report will be issued by the Board to the Ryerson community.
